

# 2019 Fact Sheet

## GENERAL INFORMATION

The Jamaica Reach to Recovery is an affiliate of the Jamaica Cancer Society and consists of a group of volunteers, all of whom are breast cancer survivors whose sole purpose is to provide emotional, psychological and financial support as well as information and counselling to breast cancer survivors and by extension their family and friends. The costs associated with the diagnosis and treatment of breast cancer can run into millions of dollars. This is out of the reach of most Jamaican women. The Pink Run, pink being the colour associated with breast cancer worldwide, is an annual event which is the primary fund raiser for Jamaica Reach to Recovery. All funds raised will provide lifesaving treatments to women across Jamaica.

In 2015, ICWI took the decision to provide support to the breast cancer survivor community in the countries that they operate. The Pink Run 5K in Jamaica was identified as a worthy partnership for them. This will be their fourth year as the Title Sponsor.

**Donation:** Individuals - \$1,500 per person. Teams (50 persons or more) - \$1,200 per person. Teams (100 persons or more) - \$1,200 per person plus a complimentary 10x10 team tent on race day.

- **Registration closes Friday, October 18, 2019** or upon achieving the event limit, whichever comes first. **ENTRIES ARE NEITHER REFUNDABLE NOR TRANSFERABLE, AND NAME CHANGES ARE NOT ALLOWED.**
- **Race packets** must be collected before race day from Toyota Jamaica, 93 Old Hope Road, Kingston 6 on Thursday, October 24 - Friday, October 25 between 11:00am to 5:00pm, or on Saturday, October 26 from 11:00am - 2:00pm. **THERE IS NO PACKET PICK-UP ON RACE DAY.**
